


Provider Access Policy Statement



Judgemeanow Community College

Aims: This statement sets out the school's arrangements for managing the access of education and training providers to students for the purpose of giving them information about their offer. As outlined in section 42B of the Education Act 1997.

Statutory requirements: We have a number of opportunities from year 7 through to year 11 for a range of education and training providers to access students for the purposes of informing them about their approved technical education, qualifications or apprenticeships.

Students Entitlement:

All students in years 7 to 11 at Judgemeanow CC are entitled to:

- Find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeship opportunities, as part of our careers programme which provides information on the full range of education and training options available at each transition point
 - Hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education and apprenticeships
 - Understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses
- Management of provider access requests
