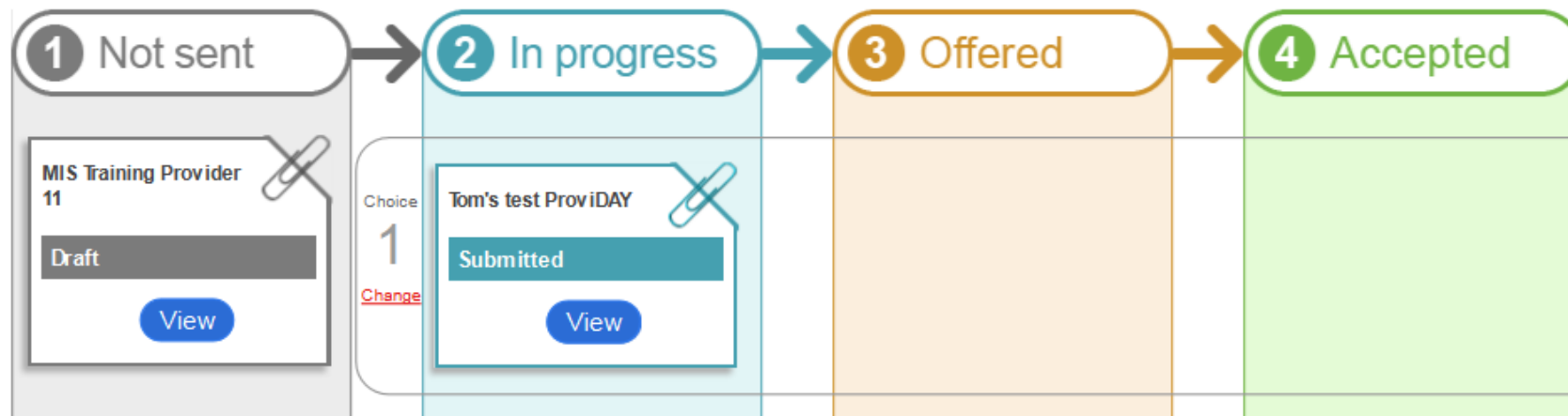
If you have any draft applications you should submit these as soon as possible. Make sure you come back and check your applications and reply to any offers or messages.

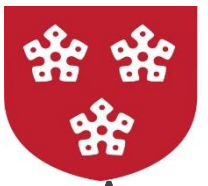

## Timeline

- Applications Completed and submitted to JMCC by 18<sup>th</sup> December
- These will be checked before submitted to colleges by 31<sup>st</sup> January
- Interviews from March to June - usually at colleges
- Offers made in April/May
- Choose places by May 10
- Exam season Tuesday May 7<sup>th</sup> - Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> June



## Results Day

- ▶ Colleges will receive results automatically
- ▶ Enrol as soon as possible or by appointment
- ▶ Ring or go and check if entry requirements have not been met.
- ▶ Be prepared to listen to options
- ▶ If exceed expectations - contact colleges direct
- ▶ Careers Staff
- ▶ Results are signed for by students/representative
