Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Will I have a friend in my tutor group?

You will be with at least one other person from the same primary school as yourself and will have plenty of opportunities to meet new friends!

Q. How will I know where to go?

When you first attend Judgemeadow, your tutors, Year team and Senior Leadership Team will be at the front of school waiting to welcome you in and direct you to the right place. You will meet members of your tutor group and your tutor. Also, if you look on the transition6 tab on our website, you'll find some key transition information. Q. What time does school start?

Our doors open at 8.10am and Tutor time begins at 8:30am.

Q. What if I get lost?

This is likely to happen at some point during the first few weeks but do not worry. Our staff and other students will support you and help you find where you need to be.

Q. How long are lessons?

Lessons are 1 hour long

Q. What if I lose my timetable and I am unsure of my next lesson?

Again, don't worry. Staff members and our admin team will be happy to tell you which lesson you should be in

Q. Do we need a pencil case?

Yes! This is very important as you will need specific equipment whilst in school. You must have two black pens, a pencil, a green pen, a ruler and a scientific calculator. You may wish to bring other items too like erasers and sharpeners. My best advice is to bring multiple pens so you always have one

Q. What time is break and lunch?

Break is from 10.50am – 11.10am. At Judgemeadow, we have a split lunch so that you're not queuing for your dinner for long. This is either from 12.10-12.45pm or 1.10-1.45pm

Q. Can I bring a pack lunch

Yes of course. As well as the panoramic café and sports café, we have areas outside for you to eat your pack lunch too

Q. How do I pay for my lunch?

At Judgemeadow, we have a cashless system. You will have an online account on our website which your parents can view and add money onto your account, or you can top up your card on the machines in school, either at the start of the day or at break or lunch.

Q. Can I wear trainers?
